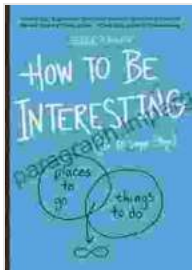

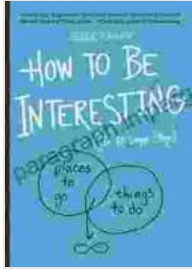


Step 7: Be Approachable

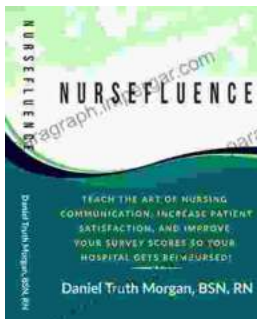
If you want people to be interested in talking to you, you need to be approachable. Smile, make eye contact, and be open to conversations. Don't be afraid to introduce yourself to new people

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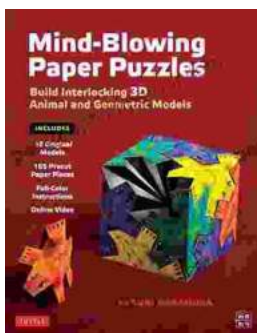


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
