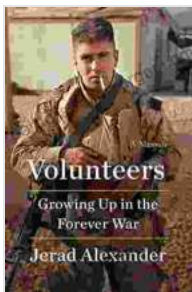


Volunteers: Growing Up in the Forever War

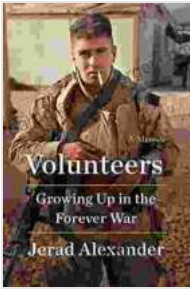

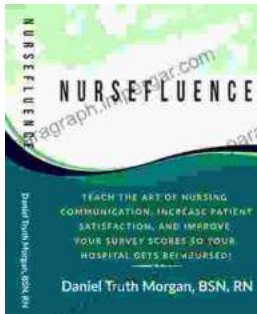

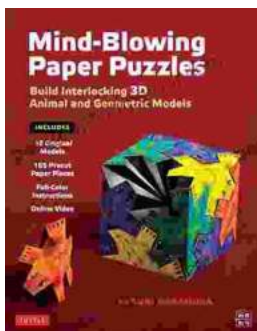
